Dear Long Prairie Water District Consumer,

We are pleased to furnish you with the following information about the water quality and services we provide to our members.

Long Prairie Water District purchases our water from the City of Tillamook as a finished product. The City does all the filtration and treatment. LPWD collects monthly samples for Coliform Bacteria levels, yearly samples for Disinfection By-Products and Lead & Copper samples every 3 years. Enclosed is the 2023 Annual Water Quality Report from the Tillamook Water Department containing contaminant test results and other important information regarding your drinking water.

Water delivery to the District enters our system from two tap points, one is located near the blinker light at Highway 101 and Long Prairie Road, and the other is near Clemens Corner on Brickyard Road.

Oregon Drinking Water Services has identified criteria for determining whether a community public water system should be considered to have outstanding performance. This designation is given at the completion of a water system survey (formerly referred to as a sanitary survey). A water system survey is an on-site review of a system's sources, treatment, storage facilities, distribution system, operation and maintenance procedures, monitoring, and management, for the purpose of evaluating the system's capability of providing safe water to the public. Systems that are designated outstanding performers will have their water system survey frequency reduced from every 3 years to every 5 years. We are happy to inform you that your LPWD water system has been named an outstanding performer with the completion of our last survey.

Our Lead and Copper sampling is on a three-year cycle and they were done in 2021. There was no significant amounts of Lead or Copper in the 10 samples tested. These will be due again in September.

We invite you to attend our monthly board meetings, held the second Monday of each month (unless an exception is approved by the Board) at 5:30 p.m. in the Port of Tillamook Bay Board Room, 6108 Hangar Rd. at the Port Offices.
